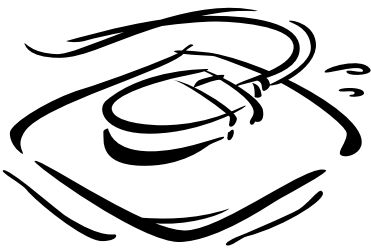

Good luck to any neighborhood children who may be participating in the 2009 All City Dive & Swim meets in August.

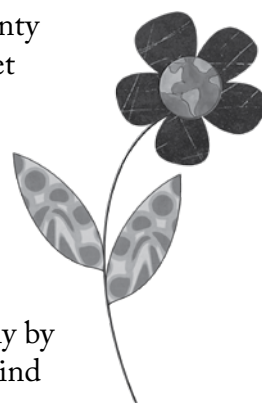
